Three (3) Continuing Education Credits (CEC) have been assigned to this half day workshop by the Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM) for Certified Floodplain Managers (CFM).

Workshop Overview: *The National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) Elevation Certificate (EC) (FEMA form 086-0-33) is an administrative tool of the NFIP which is to be used to provide elevation information necessary to ensure compliance with community floodplain management ordinances, to determine the proper insurance premium rate, or support a request for Letters of Map Change (LOMC). FEMA staff will discuss the recent changes to the current EC form. FEMA staff will also review the form in detail by each section, providing information for correct ways to fill out the form and common errors that they see during their reviews. This session is highly recommended for town officials reviewing ECs and local land surveyors or engineers responsible for filling out the form.*
