


#### Norwalk CT

- Southwest corner of state, on northern shore of Long Island Sound and about 1.5 hours from here
- ► Coastal community 6th most populous city in the state
- ▶ 36 square miles, population. ~91,000
- Oyster cultivation was an early industry in Norwalk

#### **State Of Drainage System**

- Well maintained but aging
- Most designed and built before stormwater or sewer regulation
- Very Little combined systems ++

A deadly weekend storm dumped heavy rain across the state, including the cities and towns along the Norwalk River, causing flooding and leaving a path of destruction in its


In Wilton, Route 7 was closed in three locations late Sunday night from a "100-year flood," the town's First Selectwoman Toni Boucher said Monday. A total of 8 inches of rain fell in Wilton in about seven hours on Sunday, causing the Norwalk River to overflow onto Route 7 and other roads, and the Saugatuck River to flood the Newtown Turnpike area, according to the town.

### Mitigation Program Overview

Road is selected on the paving forecast.

All components of the street, including drainage, are fully investigated. CCTV, known
drainage issues and
inspections are
utilized to determine
the scope of drainage
work required.

The On-Call
Drainage Contact is
used to replace
inadequate
drainage facilities
and mitigate
flooding.

Service requests, calls, emails and known problem locations of flooding are tracked.


A drainage investigation by the engineering department or a consult begins.

A design is developed to mitigate the flooding. Retention, detention, conveyance, etc are utilized. A project is bid out, capital funding is requested, and potential funding opportunities and grants are investigated.
